Hello Ladies,



She will have classes on Friday and Saturday after the tea (see details elsewhere) Karen Reynolds, chairperson reminded us to bring a favorite tea cup with a story and wear a memorable apron.

Ann began sewing her own clothes as a girl and now has her own alterations and sewing business. In 2004, Ann fell in love with the art of landscape quilting. The Friday class is titled, Impressionistic art quilts. It is a 5 hour class with 1/2 hour lunch break. Working from a photograph (Ann will provide) we will make a 14" X 18" art quilt by cutting and layering fabrics under polyester tulle and free-motion machine quilting. Ann will provide backing and mat board to mount finished quilt.

Saturday's class is titled, Confetti - a 3 hour class in which you will make a 4"X6" mosaic like art quilt. It will involve fusible web and free-motion machine quilting. Ann will provide backing and mat board to mount finished quilt.
